### Woodstock Work Party

Work party volunteers may earn hours on their work card toward a free Pomfret race entry. Be sure to sign-in & out. The closing work party on Monday, Sept. 5 will take place after racing has finished. Clean-up will include the camping area and the return of equipment to Pomfret.

### Woodstock - Pits & Parking

Parking Entrance- We must enter the parking area at the Main Entrance - right off the main road. See Parking Attendant for trailer parking!

Please note each day you drive into the fair, you will be expected to pay the farmer \$5.00 for parking. YOU MAY NOT enter the fair the "back way" or you will jeopardize our relationship with the farmer! You may only use the "back way" prior to 8AM or after the fair has closed. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS! Please be courteous to the Farmer's employees.

Campers- The Farmer who owns the parking areas has made an area available for campers at \$25/ night - \$100.00 for the weekend. This area is at the bottom of the hill where the campers parked last year. The camping area will open at 12:00 noon on Thursday and the Farmer will be collecting camper fees and issuing permits. Please note that the farmer is providing the camping area, not the club, so please deal with his staff. Enter the parking area through the Main Gate ONLY! Do not attempt to enter the gen. parking area prior to 12 noon or you will be asked to leave until noon. NEW: Quiet Hours in the camping area 2-7AM→Violators will be asked to leave & forfeit all racing fees paid.

Trailer Parking - The area just outside the pit gate is reserved for trailer parking only. NO CARS OR TOW VEHICLES ALLOWED. For those that want to pit out of their trailer or truck in this lot, please see the designated attendant for space assignments. Do not park in this area unless you see the attendant FIRST!

### Pit Spaces -

- \* Pit space in the trailer parking is very limited, so we are asking that you take only the room you need. There will be plenty of room in the enclosed pit area.
- \* We must leave adequate room in the pits for the Scale area and the Line-up grid area. The Club Officials have marked these areas; please respect them. Fire lane must stay open! No exceptions!
- \* There will be speakers in the pits. Please do not come to the pump around until your class is called.
- \* A pit pass will be required for entry into the pit area - no exceptions! Please do not invite friends & family into the pits without a pit-pass- even for only a minute! Anyone in the pit area without a pass will be required to leave immediately!

**NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES WILL BE USED IN THE PITS (i.e. golf karts, scooters, mini bikes, & ATVs) except official TSKC vehicles. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

### Pit Pass & Race Fees for Woodstock-all fees and sign-ins will be done just inside the pit gate.

Woodstock Fair Association will add an automatic \$8 fair fee to your pit pass daily (Master members who buy a pit pass will receive a free fair pass for each day they purchase one) but TSKC will pay \$2 of that mandated fee to offset club members' expenses. Children ages 10 & under enter fair free of charge. Club will distribute any unused fair tickets to members, fairly.

The 2nd Annual All-Star Heavy Race- Open Tire Rule, Animal, No Plate, WKA Rules, 50 laps, 375 lbs., designated area for working on kart, 20 participants, Pomfret Race Format for heats/time trials/feature (pomfretspeedway.org), & no time limit. During caution laps, officials will stop karts on the track to realign the field if it is safe to do so. Otherwise, karts will be slowed to a crawl during caution laps.

>Mandatory Driver's Meeting for ANYONE that has a pit pass!

> Race Director reserves the right to announce at the Driver's Meeting total # of laps that would determine refueling (if this is determined to be necessary, a lap counter will be used/refueling tightly monitored, driver only to refuel his kart). Dry, empty jug with kart # impounded prior to start of race.

> The TSKC All-Star race will run on Sunday, Sept. 4: Driver Intros 5:45 PM/Feature at 6 PM

> Entry fee= \$65 + \$7 fuel charge + pit pass fee

> \$1,000 total minimum purse guaranteed; pay-out 1st-6th positions

The Parent Family Memorial Race aka 'Run What Ya Brung'- Saturday, September 3 at 4:35 PM

>This will be a 30 lap, "Run What Ya Brung" race, no tech, 15 years and up.

>Must use a go-kart motor

> Stock Yamaha= 325 lbs., Reed/Rotary 2 Cycle & Limited Mods= 350 lbs., Mod & Open= 375 lbs.

>You will draw for starting position

>Mandatory Driver's Meeting for ANYONE that has a pit pass!

Ed Cerri Memorial Sr. Champ Kart Challenge-Open Tire Rule, Animal, No Plate, 425lbs, 30 laps, Pomfret Race Format applies (see pomfretspeedway.org)

>Ed Cerri Memorial Race will run on Saturday, Sept. 3: Driver Intros 5:45 PM/Feature at 6 PM

>Guaranteed \$1,000 total minimum purse to positions 1-6; \$25 to 6th place finisher (in honor of Ed)

>\$65 entry fee + \$7 fuel charge + pit pass fee

>Mandatory Driver's Meeting for ANYONE that has a pit pass!

WSF 3 Day Champion Awards for Heavy, Sr. Champ, and Sr. Champ Clone Classes

>Awarded to drivers with the overall best 1-3rd place finishes Saturday, Sunday, Monday

>1st place= \$250, 2nd place= \$150, 3rd place= \$100

WSF 3 Day Champion Awards for Any Junior Classes with at least 5 karts/day (same as above)

>1st place= \$75 gift card to Game Stop, 2nd place= \$50 gift card, 3rd place= \$25 gift card

### ***In Closing!***

*Woodstock Fair is a great weekend, however, 4 days of intense racing & pitting in close quarters can often try both your patience and our patience. We ask the following:*

- > Absolutely NO FENCE JUMPING or entering fair by Scorer's Booth! Use fair entrance!*
- > Drivers get free passes into fair; if we have extras, club will distribute them fairly.*
- > If you have a question or a problem, please bring it to the attention of a Club Official. We will try to do all we can. A positive attitude on your part will greatly assist the race officials in clearing up your problem. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated!*
- > If you see that there is a problem developing, please take the initiative, step-in, and help!*
- > A POSITIVE ATTITUDE is a requirement for the fair. With this many people in the pits & on a tight track, there are bound to be some problems and issues. We ask that you deal with these issues with some understanding and perhaps a smile. HAVE FUN!*
- > Woodstock is a very tight track & requires some give and take on the drivers' part. Rough driving will not be tolerated. If you are out of control or too aggressive, expect the black flag. During the fair we always have tremendous crowds and we want to represent our club and the sport of karting in a favorable light. Let's give them a great show!*

*\*Remember, due to Race #8 being rained-out, this race will be rescheduled for Saturday, 9/17 with Race #10 the next day on Sunday, 9/18. \*\*The next club meeting will be held at Pomfret Speedway on Saturday, 9/17 after make-up Race #8.*
